The school premises is in a 25 acre farm land encompassed by sylvan surroundings with unpolluted water and air at Shivanvoil Village near Pakkam, Thiruvallure District with a close access from Thirunindravur, a sub-urban area of Chennai city. The school is administered by selfless, service minded personnel from the Managing Committee of Vivekananda Educational Society with proven capabilities in establishing and running schools.

Well qualified, dedicated and deeply devoted teaching faculty equipped with rich teaching experience take care of the curricular and co-curricular activities of the students under the able guidance of the head of the institution who has played a major role in developing a Senior Secondary School - a temple of learning - with the added experience of having been the Education Officer in the Society.

RESIDENCE

Round the clock care and attention for the holistic development of boys is our special feature. Their day starts from 5.30 am and extends upto 9.30 pm before they go to bed.

Spacious class rooms, fully equipped science laboratories and a computer centre, well furnished library etc. provide more access for self learning and exhibiting creativity, even outside the class hours.

The boys are accommodated in modern, spacious dormitory, under the care of an able warden round the clock.

A well maintained kitchen in the campus provides wholesome, hygienic and nutritive vegetarian food.

Fresh milk, vegetables and fruits are produced in the premises to meet the requirements of the students.

Periodical medical check up for all is available and regular visits by a medical practitioner cater to the needy.

GENERAL INFORMATION TO PARENTS

The parents/guardians are free to visit their boys on the fourth Sunday of every month.

Students will be asked to write letters to their parents and guardians periodically. Parents are requested to reply in turn.

Progress of the students' studies will be intimated to the parents/guardians at regular intervals.

Parents will be allowed to take their boys home only during authorized holidays. Permission will be granted for special occasions or any other unavoidable circumstances on direct request by parents.

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

Application can be obtained along with details of fees etc. on payment of Rs.100 by M.O. or DD favouring "Vivekananda Educational Society" payable at Chennai. Prospectus/application forms may also be downloaded from the website; www.vvka.org Applications printed from the website may be sent along with an application fee of Rs.100 in the form of DD/MO.

Application forms duly filled in, should be sent to the registered office at Chennai. Admission of students would be made on the basis of entrance test to assess the basic knowledge of the students in English, Maths and Science. Eligible students will be admitted after a personal interview.
